

Change of School Hours Consultationsome comments so far



"After School Care needs to run until 6pm to be successful. 5pm is not late enough for working parents."

At the moment our uptake for after-school care has increased but numbers are still low and often we are struggling to cover the cost of staffing and snacks/drinks. We could trial after-school care running later but there would need to be enough children using this service. Currently our caretaker is contracted to work until 5.30pm and so this would mean a potential change of hours/ contract to a 6pm finish.

"The 5-minute staggered finish time is not enough to alleviate any parking issues and you haven't considered a staggered start in the morning."

We take this on board and are conscious of parents of KS1 and KS2 children having to wait for a long period of time before picking up their older child. Please note this is a proposed change and we are open to changing this.

"Marsh Lane Under 5s finish at 3.15pm two days a week and so parents can't be in two places at once."

We are in discussions with with Marsh Lane Under 5's Preschool regarding negotiating school finish times. We understand that parents can't be in two places at once and will make sure this does not happen.

"Removal of Afternoon break is not a good idea. Our children need time away from learning to socialise and to have a brain break."

We still have a 15-minute morning break and 1 hour dinner break which is longer than some other local schools, who have shortened their dinner to 40 minutes with no afternoon break. We only recently introduced afternoon break, having never had it previously. We have however reflected on this and discovered there is a loss of learning time during this transition and an increased in accidents and behavioural incidents during this afternoon break. A large part of our philosophy of education here at Marsh Lane is surrounding collaborative learning. This involves using many KAGAN structures which encourage active participation, cooperative work and opportunities for children to be out of their seat with increased oxygen to the brain.
